The sobriety requirements are 5 yrs and approval of your sponsor. You should also have some additional service background (such as in your meetings or in your intergroup).

As a full delegate you will participate in four meetings a year; three of which are conference calls, the fourth is attendance at the summer international convention. For 2015 this conference will be held in Chicago.
